

Installation instructions

1. The SDM USB-C Interface Board and its components are sensitive to static electricity (ESD) and other damage. Therefore, exercise caution when handling and inspecting this product to ensure the integrity of the product at all times.
2. Switch off the Display, or the SDM Standalone Adapter completely using the toggle switch, or disconnect the device completely from the mains before inserting the SDM USB-C Interface Board into the device.
3. The SDM USB-C Interface Board starts automatically after switching on the Display.

Installation steps for Sharp NEC M series displays

Remove the two cover plates that close the slot by loosening the four Phillips screws.	Remove the centre guide rail by carefully pulling it out.	Ensure that the SDM USB-C Interface Board is inserted in the correct orientation. Carefully insert the SDM into the slot until you feel it click into place. Do not use force!	Ensure that the Interface Board slides into the guide rails provided. Now use the screws that previously secured the cover plates to fix the SDM USB-C Interface Board in place.

Installation steps for Sharp NEC displays of the ME1 series


Remove the cover plate that closes the slot by loosening the two Phillips screws.	Remove the centre guide rail by carefully pulling it out.	On certain displays, the SDM USB-C Interface Board is not completely enclosed by the display. In this case, a cover plate is included with the display, which is primarily intended to make SDM USB-C Interface Board inaccessible.	Ensure that the SDM USB-C Interface Board is inserted in the correct orientation. Make sure that the Interface Board slides into the guide rails provided. Now use the screws that previously secured the cover plates to fix the SDM USB-C Interface Board in place.

Safety instructions

1. Please note that the combination of SDM USB-C Interface Board is approved up to a maximum ambient temperature of 40°. Higher temperatures can cause damage to the display and SDM USB-C Interface Board or reduce the service life. The operating altitude must be between 0 m and 3000 m above sea level.
2. If you want to remove the SDM USB-C Interface Board from the slot, make sure that the SDM USB-C Interface Board has cooled down sufficiently.
3. Dust must be removed from the SDM USB-C Interface Board (and the display if applicable) regularly (e.g. every 3 months). How often cleaning is necessary depends very much on the operating hours, the ambient temperature and the degree of dust in the environment. Compressed air, for example, can be used for cleaning to remove dust.
4. The device must be used in accordance with the operating instructions or data sheet.
5. All instructions for installation, maintenance, transport or storage that are necessary for the safety of the plug-in board or the user must be observed.
6. To ensure sufficient air circulation for device cooling, make sure that the ventilation openings are not covered and that the system is not installed in areas (e.g. housing) where there is no or insufficient air circulation. Ensure unobstructed ventilation by maintaining a distance of at least 10 cm from the ventilation openings to its surroundings. Do not install the system near heat sources or in damp locations.
7. Only devices or parts that fulfil the requirements of the currently valid safety standards may be connected to the existing interfaces.
8. Do not insert any metal objects or other foreign bodies into the appliance.

**TROUBLESHOOTING**

1. The SDM USB-C Interface Board does not start
 - a. Is the SDM USB-C Interface Board correctly seated in the slot and are the screws tightened?
Press the reset button or restore the original Firmware configuration. Firmware can be found at our Service website at : <http://nec-sbc-service.com>
2. The SDM USB-C Interface Board starts, but I can't see a picture
 - a. Is "Option" selected as the input?
 - b. Check the USB-C cable connection, the cable may be too long and therefore the signal quality too poor. Check this by using a shorter cable, e.g. 1.5 - 2 metres
3. The image appears blurred
 - a. Is the correct resolution set?
For the native resolution of your monitor/projector, please refer to the operating instructions or the data sheet of the respective device. This resolution should also be selected in the operating system of the plug-in PC.
 - b. The display may be set to a different size. Press the "Size" button or "Aspect" on the remote control until "Standard" is displayed in green at the top right.
 - c. unplug the USB-C cable from the connected device and Interface Board and reconnect again
4. A device connected via USB does not work properly
 - a. Make sure that all drivers are installed.
 - b. Contact the manufacturer of the USB device.
 - c. Check the USB-C cable connection, the cable may be too long and therefore the signal quality too poor. Check this by using a shorter cable, e.g. 1.5 - 2 metres
